 **390,000**

A number of earthquakes have hit the island of Lombok in Indonesia. The strongest struck on 5 August and measured 7.0 magnitude. The aftershocks that followed caused widespread damage to homes and public infrastructure and hampered rescue efforts. More than 390,000 people have been displaced. Many are traumatised by the on-going tremors.
