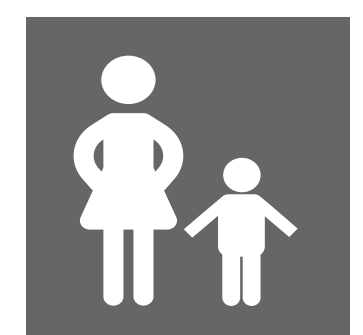

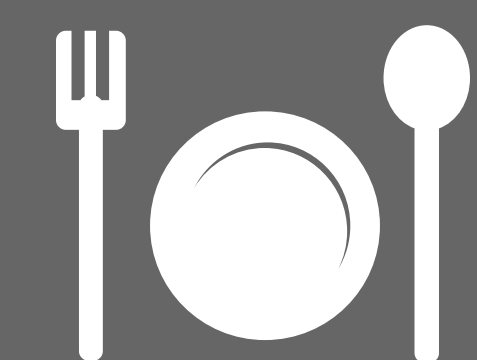

## The context

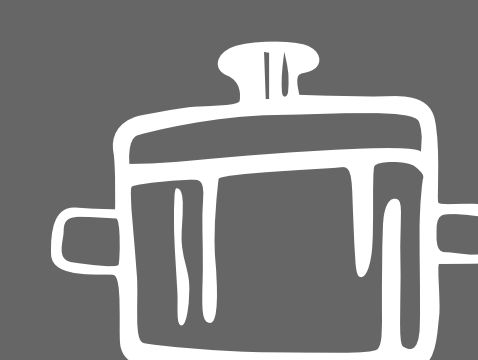
 +890,000

- Typhoon Mangkhut (known locally as Ompong) made landfall on the largest and most northern island of the Philippines, on September 15.
- High winds of up to 255 kph (158mph), flash flooding and landslides caused extensive damage to homes and infrastructure.
- Nearly 900,000 people are affected and more than 230,000 people are displaced.
- Crops have been devastated and large areas of floodwater remain with an increased risk of waterborne diseases.

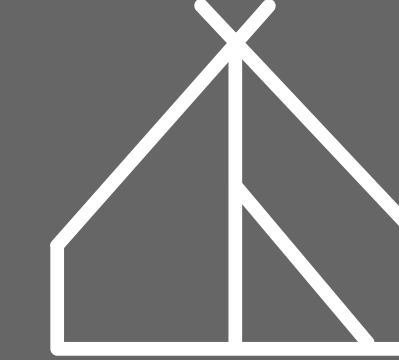

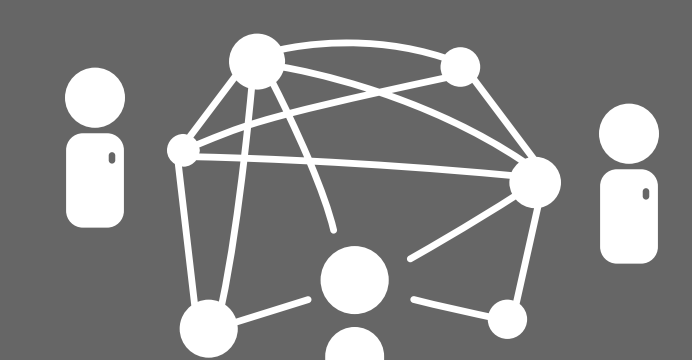
